

<b>Florida Registry Requirements are for Life</b>		
<b><u>Count of Requirements</u></b>	<b><u>Added</u></b>	<b><u>Registration Requirement</u></b>
<b>1</b>	1997	Report within 48 Hours after establishing a permanent or temporary residence
<b>2</b>	1997	Registration must include name, date of birth, race, sex, height, weight, hair and eye color, tattoos or other identifying marks, address of permanent or legal residence
<b>3</b>	1997	Report to DHSMV within 48 hours after change in address.
<b>4</b>	1998	Additional qualifying offenses
<b>5</b>	1998	Registration must include Social security number, occupation and place of employment, rural route address and a post office box, post office box cannot be used in lieu of physical residential address, written notice of vehicle identification number, license tag number, registration number, a description including color scheme, hull identification number, manufacturer's serial number, name of vessel, registration number and description including color scheme
<b>6</b>	1998	Address verification at residence
<b>7</b>	1998	Internet notification
<b>8</b>	1998	Ability to Petition for removal 20 years AFTER all sanctions are completed
<b>9</b>	2000	Must report out-of-state addresses
<b>10</b>	2000	County/local law enforcement must verify address.
<b>11</b>	2002	Additional qualifying offenses
<b>12</b>	2002	Persons subject to registration in another state must register
<b>13</b>	2002	Must register enrollment in an institution of higher education
<b>14</b>	2002	Must report employment within 48 hours
<b>15</b>	2002	Registrants visiting from out of state will be on FL for life.
<b>16</b>	2004	Must provide address for temporary address
<b>17</b>	2004	If you reported a change in address and fail to vacate, 2nd degree felony.
<b>18</b>	2004	Strict Liability - can be prosecuted for unknowing violations
<b>19</b>	2004	Registration after arrest not a defense
<b>20</b>	2004	Residency Restrictions - Cannot live w/l 1000 ft of school, park, playground or daycare center
<b>21</b>	2005	Semi-Annual registration required
<b>22</b>	2007	Additional qualifying offenses
<b>23</b>	2007	Registration of Email Address, IM and Internet Identifiers required
<b>24</b>	2007	Quarterly registration for some
<b>25</b>	2007	Branded drivers' licenses
<b>26</b>	2007	Certain enumerated offenses can never petition for removal
<b>27</b>	2007	5 more years before one can petition for removal (hence cannot petition for removal for 25 years AFTER all sanctions are completed)
<b>28</b>	2009	Home and cellphone numbers must be registered
<b>29</b>	2010	"Transient residence" must be reported every 30 days
<b>30</b>	2012	Additional qualifying offenses
<b>31</b>	2013	Fingerprints and photographs required
<b>32</b>	2014	Additional qualifying offenses
<b>33</b>	2014	Internet Identifiers including URLs must be reported before using
<b>34</b>	2014	Vehicles at residence must be registered
<b>35</b>	2014	Vehicles leased or rented must be registered
<b>36</b>	2014	Palm Prints must be taken at registration
<b>37</b>	2014	Year, Make, Model, Mile, VIN, Tag of vehicles must be reported

<b>38</b>	2014	Passports are marked
<b>39</b>	2014	Must report Immigration status (Citizenship)
<b>40</b>	2014	Professional licenses must be reported
<b>41</b>	2014	Volunteer Status must be reported
<b>42</b>	2014	Additional Genetic Markers (DNA Sample) must be provided
<b>43</b>	2014	Transients must report every 30 days.
<b>44</b>	2014	Report 21 days before leaving the country.
<b>45</b>	2016	Additional qualifying offenses
<b>46</b>	2016	Online reporting of Internet IDs, phone numbers, employment education.
<b>47</b>	2016	Expanded international travel reporting.
<b>48</b>	2017	Corresponding website, homepage or application software for each Internet Identifier must be reported.
<b>49</b>	2018	Reduced residence reporting to 3 days from 5.
<b>50</b>	2018	Mandatory minimum sentence for Failure to Register (FTR)
<b>51</b>	2018	Mandatory GPS monitoring for Failure to Register (FTR)
<b>52</b>	2020	No timesharing with own children absent Judge's written finding.
